1. Pension updation is a big issue and Bank Pensioners would make it done.
2. Old Bank Pensioners are being neglected. We have no bargaining power. There is disparity in pension. Some Ex GMs are getting less pension than some Ex Award Staff Members. Why Govt. will not look into?
3. Digital India: Recent frauds faced by Bank Retirees. Big losses in the accounts they are facing. False phone calls giving names of H.O officials are being received by Bank Retirees. He faced a fraud of Rs.14 lacs and the amount is not still recovered. Indeed, Bank Pensioners are victims today.

He supported GS Report and expected that Federation and AIBPARC would take steps to redress the issues.

COM. BIJOY KRISHNA BANERJEE [WEST BENGAL]

1. District Committees should function properly. Functioning of District Committees should be placed in GS Report.
2. Pensioners are facing various problems in Branches. One is signatures of Bank Pensioners are not tallied at their end. This issue is to be incorporated in coming GR Meeting at H.O.
3. 75% Retirees are members of AIUCBOF Welfare and Benevolent Trust. Retiree Trustees are to be included in Trustee Board.

He thanked the entire team of Bihar for holding such Grand Conference of AIUCBPF in Bodhgaya, Bihar. He supported GS Report 2023-26.

COM. GOUTAM MUKHERJEE [WEST BENGAL]

He thanked Presidium and all Delegates, Observers. He supported GS Report.

1. Bad approach of Bank Management. Physical Mediclaim Cards not yet received by all eligible Bank Retirees.
2. Pension Fund: He talked on Pension Fund Security aspects. Not real information in Balance Sheet of the Bank on Pension Fund. Movement of Pension Fund not reflected in BS properly. Pension Fund is used in NPA Management of the Banks. Management of Pension Fund is not trustworthy. If any defalcation of fund happens, who will take care? Representative of Pensioners' Organization is required in Trustee Board.
3. He said when in service, Pensioners used to get PF Statements. If that is possible, why regular statements on pension fund not possible? Govt. may decline any time.
4. Revision of Pension: All types of agitation, AIBPARC has organized in the country. Even Hunger Strike Programmes have also taken place. But still Govt. is not sympathetic to us. IBA is denying. Why? Hearing dates on M.C.Singla Case are always getting deferred. It is good that few Members of Parliament have stood by Bank Retirees on Pension Revision issue. Our Organization is non political. As such, there are some hindrances also.

He thanked Bihar Unit for excellent fooding and lodging arrangements. He will remember the Conference for his entire life time.

COM. M.M.BORO [NORTH EAST]

1. He said that Pension Updation is the long pending issue of the Bank Retirees. Rs.4,20,000 Crore is in Pension Fund which is the money of Bank Retirees. Justice is to be given to Bank Retirees. It is surprising that 30 years have passed but

He called the House as MAHAMILAN KHETRA where Delegates and Observers from various parts of the country have today assembled.

1. He expected that our long pending issue Pension Updation is going to be addressed this year.
2. He discussed on exemption of GST on insurance premium payment by Bank Retirees.
3. He focused the pending issue on early restoration of commutation. He opined that excess money for 4 years have been taken from Retirees.
4. He demanded that medical subsidy for full insurance premium amount is to be borne by respective Banks.
5. He said Grade Pay is not being considered for retirement benefit.
6. He said with unity, Bank Retirees would succeed in coming days.

COM. K.K.DEKA [NORTH EAST]

1. During the Conference Time, a Medical Camp should be held for the Comrades present in the Conference.
2. Physical Health Cards not yet provided to all eligible Bank Retirees.
3. AIUCBOF WELFARE AND BENEVOLENT TRUST: For sanction by Trust, 80% of unsettled amount is to be considered – this is not good. Previously it was 100% of total claim.
4. IBA Group Mediclaim Policy : Full Premium is to be borne by Banks.

He supported GS Report.

COM. C.A.NAGARATNA [KARNATAKA]

1. He praised well drafted GS Report.
2. He expressed that Karnataka State Unit keeps good relation with Zonal Head, UCO Bank, Bengaluru.

3. He cautioned Bank Retirees to avoid recent Cyber Frauds faced by Retirees.
4. He informed the House that Karnataka Unit felicitate every year Super Senior Bank Retirees.

COM. SM. TARA MADHAB [KARNATAKA]

1. She was a victim of recent Cyber Fraud. She informed the House how on 29/11/2024 and 30/11/2024 she faced unauthorized debit and credit transactions in her SB accounts online with her KENGERI BRANCH, MYSORE ROAD, BENGALURU. She received phone calls in Bengali and Hindi Voice. As informed, the call was from ATM Cell of the Bank. It was her misfortune that she clicked on link and after so many calls she shared the OTP. All the necessary procedures to recover the lost money, she has followed. She contacted with Branch, HO, Police, Cyber Crime Cell. But till date no recovery in her account. Her only submission was: DO I GET BACK THE AMOUNT? She expressed that she has not received any help from HO, Cyber Crime Cell, Police.
2. She requested Federation Leadership to initiate in the matter with HO for recovery.

COM. P.L.SHARMA [PUNJAB]

1. Punjab Unit was established in 2010. But strength of members is not adequate.
2. On 28/2/2026 in their Conference Election was held and a new Team was elected. 65 members cast votes. Election result was 16:49. Team led by Com. P.L.Sharma got 49 votes and Opponent Team got 16 votes.
3. The General Secretary of the Old Team was having a very rude behavior for members. He expelled some members also. He always ignored the requests of members. His attitude was very shameful.
4. It is very surprising that Old Team led by the then Secretary did not hand over any paper, bill and cash in hand, mobile, membership lists to new General Secretary of the Unit Com. P.L.Sharma.
5. He thanked Bihar Unit and conveyed gratitude to them for holding such excellent arrangements.
6. He supported GS Report.

COM. R.K.PANDEY [UTTAR PRADESH]

1. He praised GS Report and supported it.
2. IBA GROUP MEDICLAIM POLICY: He wanted to know whether Dental Treatment is covered under the Policy or not.

1. He talked on IBA GROUP MEDICAL POLICY. He opined against amount debited for GST for insurance premium payment of Bank Retirees.
2. He discussed on digital banking. Any app can be downloaded through Google Play Store. He discussed various benefits of mobile banking operation.
3. He expressed in detail the benefits of HRMS for the Bank Retirees. He said that all Retirees should take approval of HRMS from HO, to download HRMS and avail of all the benefits given to Bank Retirees. Holiday Home [offered by Bank] Booking for Bank Retirees has now become very easy. All the Bank Retirees should take the advantage of Holiday Home Booking through HRMS.

COM. TRIDIB CHARAN CHOWDHURY [WEST BENGAL]

1. He discussed on Kerala High Court Case on GST for refund to Bank Retirees. But GST deducted on insurance premium not yet refunded to Bank Retirees. Group Insurance in Banks is a welfare scheme for Bank Retirees. Court will have to decide whether GST on insurance premium payment will be abolished or not.
2. He said, we have huge pension fund. But we are not getting pension revision. Pension updation issue is very difficult one. It will be generated by income generation of pension fund. No provision in Balance Sheet of the Bank for gratuity, commutation etc. Our pension is not funded. Bank has to provide it. We are in great fear whether we can get pension in near future.
3. Everyone in the country is suffering for one person i.e Donald Trump [45th and 47th U.S. President]. He is turmoiling world peace. He changed several Govts of several countries like Bangladesh. Com. Chowdhury talked on some recent war issues between Iran and America.
4. Commutation restoration issue not yet settled.
5. He supported GS Report.

COM. AMRENDRA KUMAR SINHA [BIHAR]

1. We are happy that we have got the opportunity to hold All India Conference of ALL INDIA UCO BANK PENSIONERS' FEDERATION in Bodhgaya, Bihar. Total 14 Delegates/Observers have interacted on GS Report and he thanked them all for pointing out some important issues on GS Report. However, he said that he would not reply to each point raised by all the Speakers as some are mere repetition. But he would definitely reply to all the important and valid points/issues as picked up by them.

1. On different Occasions, CBPRO and AIBPARC gave various calls like sending communications to PM, Home Minister, FM of GOI by general members to resolve long pending issues of Bank Retirees, holding Hunger Strikes, Dharna Programmes at all the capitals of the country and all agitation Programmes. Federation has tried their best to make each Programme successful and all State Units have stood by Federation and made all the Programme grand success. Dharna at Jantar Mantar, Delhi was a big successful show where large number of our Office Bearers and members from various Units attended.
2. RECENT DIGITAL FRAUDS faced by our members: Federation is very much watching over the entire happenings, following up with the concerned departments of the Bank for recovery. More over in last GR meeting held on 20/1/2026 in HO-1, Kolkata this sensitive issue was placed for discussion. Bank Officials commented in the meeting that various initiatives have been taken by HO IT and CISO team for sensitizing Retirees to remain alert to such fraudsters in social media and other platforms. Concerned department of HO is sending SMS alerts, e mails, video conferencing etc. They have also said that steps have already been taken by the department to recover the amounts due to fraudulent debits. GS Com. Sarkar appealed to all Delegates/Observers to remain alert at this moment and sensitize all general members not to accept unknown calls, not to click unknown links, not to share OTP. As far as possible, Bank related works are to be completed at concerned Branches by physical presence. Definitely, if possible. Whenever any fund loss will arise, he suggested following precautionary steps to follow:
 - A. Please make a phone call 1930 and to inform them the whole matter.
 - B. Contact with Branch and submit your representation.
 - C. Contact with Cyber Department of Local Police Station and hand over to them your letter of informing fund loss.
 - D. Please inform the whole thing to any Association Comrade known to you.
3. No proper Retiree Representative in Trustee Board of AIUCBOF Welfare and Benevolent Trust. He fully agreed with the view that as more than 70% of membership of AIUCBOF Welfare and Benevolent Trust belongs to Retirees, it is just demand to nominate good number of Trustees from Retirees. He assured the House that necessary Resolution will be passed in this House and the same would be sent to the Chairman, AIUCBOF Welfare and Benevolent Trust shortly.
4. No Representative from our Organization in Pension Fund of the Bank. We will continue our demand for nominating one Representative from our Organization in Pension Fund.

5. Early restoration of commutation for Bank Retirees: He apprised the House that as per direction of GOI, Pay Commission is considering this demand at their end and he hoped a positive result shortly.
6. Problems of our Punjab Unit: He shortly described the present situation of our Punjab Unit and requested Senior Comrade Ashok Kumar Handa ji to stand by the Punjab Unit and to give them necessary guidance.
7. Registration of Federation: He said that some hindrances are there and it would be overcome soon.
8. GS said that Unity is our strength. He viewed that we shall have to be united to solve our issues. We have to fight to get our pending issues resolved.
9. Finally, he thanked entire Bihar Unit for holding such big Conference successfully. He Conveyed his heartfelt gratitude to Com. A.K.Verma Ji, Com. S.M.Ahmad Ji, Com.R.P.Yadav Ji, Com. Amrendra Kumar Sinha Ji, Com. Manoj Kumar Ji and all other activists of Bihar Unit for such herculean task to make the Conference Remembering one. Delegates and Observers of the Conference would remember this gathering and interactions for a long time. He further said that fooding and lodging arrangements made by Bihar Unit have pleased all Delegates and Observers and Federation is also happy to see such excellent arrangements.

After end of reply placed by GS,AIUCBPF, GS REPORT 2023-26 was adopted unanimously with clapping of the full House.

Any other matter:

1. Com. Rampal ji, President, AIUCBPF and Com. A.K.Verma ji, Jt.GS, AIUCBPF discussed on dental issue including dental surgery in IBA Group Medical Policy. If we follow proper procedure, our claim for dental surgery bill reimbursement can not be denied. Com. Rampal, President, AIUCBPF also discussed how a long pending issue [starting of Family Pension] was resolved by continuous follow up by Federation Leadership. In 4 consecutive Grievance Redressal Meetings, the issue was placed by Federation before Management. The issue was – despite sanction of family pension of Mrs. Surekha Baberwal, wife of late Shri Ashok Kumar [Employee No. 21495] by Pension Department and withdrawal of Court Case and submission of all papers to Station Road, Ajmer Branch by her, arrears and pension have not been released in her favour for a long time. But Federation Leadership compelled the Management at last and family pension was initiated from January, 2026 and arrears were released in her favour up till date. Indeed this is a big achievement by continuous follow up of Federation. Again and again Bank tried to deny the issue but ultimately failed. In Open Session of the Conference, Com. Rampal Ji included this issue in his address.
2. Com. K.P.Sahu, Dy.GS, AIUCBPF day care issues of IBA Group Policy. He explained one day care issue. In day care, to send intimation is a must.
3. Com. L.N.Sharma, AGS, AIUCBPF discussed in detail M.C.Singla Case in Supreme court on pension updation. He opined, we will surely win the case. He also viewed

that in early restoration of commutation, our result will be very positive. The commutation period is going to be reduced from 15 years to 12 years. Here his observation is that, we will win the case.

The Accounts of the Federation for the year ended 31/3/2024, 31/3/2025, 31/3/2026 were placed by Com. Basudeb De, Treasurer, AIUCBPF and after some discussions all the Accounts as placed by Treasurer, AIUCBPF were passed unanimously.

Next Agenda was to consider and pass the amendments of Constitution of AIUCBPF, if any.

Com. Subrata Sarkar, GS, AIUCBPF informed the House that Constitution Amendment Committee of Federation held a Meeting on 11.4.2026 and they considered some amendments in Constitution of Federation which GS, AIUCBPF placed before the House.

1. Subscriptions of Units: Per member per year subscription will be Rs.75/- in place of Rs.50/- per member per year from January, 2026. Ceiling of subscription for a Unit in a year will be maximum Rs.1,25,000/-.
2. Creation of some New Posts.
 - a. 1 Chairman Post [Existing no Chairman Post]
 - b. Working Presidents will be two in place of one.
 - c. Senior Vice Presidents Posts will be five in place of three.
 - d. Dy. General Secretaries Posts will be six in place of four.
3. Duties of Office Bearers [Chairman] – He will address Office Bearers' Meetings, Governing Body Meetings of AIUCBPF and Triennial Conference of AIUCBPF in the beginning as First Speaker. All other entire proceedings of the Meetings will be conducted by the President. In absence of President, all Meetings of AIUCBPF will be conducted by Working President. In case any dispute arises and equal voting [favour/disfavour] arises, Chairman will have a right to cast decisive vote. Chairman will appoint Election Commissioner to conduct Governing Body of Federation in Triennial Conference. Election Process of Federation in Triennial Conference will be managed by Chairman in consultation with President. Chairman will provide necessary guidance to Office Bearers/ Governing Body members as and when situation warranted.
4. A Retiree who is Office Bearer in any Working Employees/Officers' Union can not be included as Office Bearer or EC Member of Federation.
5. If an OB is absent in two consecutive meetings of Federation, his name will not be considered for any New Post in Federation Committee.
6. All State General Secretaries and State Presidents are eligible to attend Governing Body meetings of Federation. All Advisers are also eligible to attend Governing Body Meeting of Federation.

7. Every year one Governing Body Meeting or one Office Bearer Meeting of Federation will be held.

1. To attend Grievance Redressal Meeting in HO-1, Kolkata: Federation will provide 2 Tier AC fare [Railway] forward and return journey, fooding and lodging expenses to the concerned Office Bearers who will attend from other States.

Schedule of next Meetings of Federation was discussed and agreed in the Meeting:

1. Next Governing Body Meeting of Federation will be held in Bengaluru, Karnataka in the month of April/May, 2027. Our Karnataka Unit will take care of the Meeting.
2. Next Office Bearers' Meeting for 2028 of Federation will be organized by our Andhra Pradesh and Telengana Unit. Date and Venue of the Meeting will be informed later.
